Our Programs





CLUB KINABUHI (CLUB LIFE)

Club Kinabuhi provides support to vulnerable students and their families through weekly gatherings, offering child protection lessons, engaging in Bible studies, and distributing monthly food packs.



CHILD PROTECTION TRAINING

Our trainings equip communities, churches, teachers, and parents with the knowledge and skills to recognize and respond effectively to signs of abuse, ensuring the safety and well-being of children.



BARANGAY OUTREACH

In barangays, we conduct 10-week lessons using our prevention education curriculum "I Can Be Strong, Smart, and Safe," empowering children with skills and knowledge to protect themselves from abuse.




REMOTE ISLAND PARTNERSHIPS

We actively collaborate with churches on remote islands to conduct trainings for church staff and volunteers, parents, and children, ensuring comprehensive support and education on child protection measures.

Impact Stories

A JOURNEY OF RESILIENCE AND HOPE

In October 2019, we introduced you to Zoe**, who bravely disclosed that she was being groomed for online sexual exploitation, marking the first self-reported case of its kind in the Philippines. Her home environment, tainted by other forms of abuse, prompted authorities to place her and her older sister in a government facility for their safety. For four years and through a few transitions, our team remained a constant source of support, staying connected, celebrating birthdays, and providing the love and encouragement they needed to thrive.



Zoe and her sister have shown incredible growth over the years. This year, after their home was deemed safe they returned, reintegrated into

our programs, and found peace in their faith. During our founder's recent trip to Cebu, Zoe shared with our team her heartfelt gratitude. She expressed,

"I am thankful to God that you never left our side."

Today, you can find Zoe hanging out with her friends at church or finding ways to serve others during our bi-weekly Club Kinabuhi gatherings.

BUILDING STRONGER FOUNDATIONS

In 2019, Club Kinabuhi started as an after-school program for 30 vulnerable youth, but wow, has it become something amazing! This past year, we focused on inviting and involving the youth in the local church. By providing them with transportation, it opened doors of opportunities to deepen their faith and develop a sense of belonging.

Through Club Kinabuhi, our youth not only learn valuable life skills and

lessons in child protection but they now receive guidance and support from church family and mentors.



Furthermore, several teens had the opportunity to participate in a life-changing youth camp during the summer months. This experience further solidified their faith and fostered meaningful connections with fellow believers and mentors.



It's been inspiring to witness the positive impact of these efforts on the lives of our teens, as they navigate their faith journey with newfound resilience and hope. It's like they've found a second family!

AMPLIFYING OUR MISSION

Throughout the year, we participated in numerous speaking engagements, amplifying our mission and reach. One highlight was Ivy's speech at the Code Red Conference, equipping the church to reach the next generation. With hundreds present, Ivy raised awareness on child safety, forging nationwide connections.


These moments reflect the impact of our work, inspiring advocates for change.

Finance

In a significant milestone for Redeeming Zoe, we raised over \$100,000 this year, marking a first in our seven-year history! It's a testament to the incredible support of our donors and partners. Despite this increase in funds, we remained careful with our expenses, totaling just \$83,000 for the year. This careful stewardship ensures that the majority of our resources directly benefit our programs and initiatives, including things like printing prevention education booklets and providing food packs for families.

Additionally, we're grateful to have received the government ERC credit, further bolstering our financial stability and ability to serve our mission.
